- Advocate for policy changes to advance victims' rights & protections at both the state & federal levels.

PREVENTION EDUCATION



- Work with youth and communities to prevent violence before it happens
- Design and implement innovative statewide educational campaigns

SUPPORT FOR SURVIVORS



- Coordinate the AmeriCorps Victim Assistance Program (AVAP)
- Train Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners (SANE) to provide forensic medical care in New Hampshire hospitals

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE



- Coordinate the Family Violence Prevention Specialist (FVPS) Program in collaboration with DCYF
- Provide training & technical assistance to all 12 crisis centers to ensure quality care for survivors

HUMAN TRAFFICKING



- Collaborate with the Human Trafficking Task Force to develop and implement a multidisciplinary and trauma-informed response to trafficking in New Hampshire
