- Advocate for policies to advance victims' rights and protections at the state and federal levels

PREVENTION EDUCATION



- Work with youth and communities to prevent violence before it occurs
- Design and implement innovative statewide educational campaigns

SUPPORT FOR SURVIVORS



- Coordinate statewide programs that support survivors in accessing and maintaining safe and stable housing
- Train Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners (SANEs) to provide forensic medical care in NH hospitals

TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE



- Coordinate the Family Violence Prevention Specialist (FVPS) Program in collaboration with DCYF
- Provide training and technical assistance to NH's crisis centers to ensure quality care for survivors

HUMAN TRAFFICKING



- Collaborate with the NH Human Trafficking Collaborative Task Force to develop and implement a multidisciplinary and trauma-informed response to trafficking in the state
