On average, nearly 20 people per minute are physically abused by an intimate partner in the United States

1 in 4 women and 1 in 7 men have been victims of severe physical violence by an intimate partner. Women aged 18-24 are most at risk for this type of abuse.

In New Hampshire, at least 33% of women and nearly 25% of men have been the victim of a physical assault by an intimate partner.
